SBHI's Substance Abuse Services include outpatient counseling, group counseling, care coordination, peer support, medication-assisted treatment, assessment, and ambulatory detox. These services are delivered in Montgomery County. Our mental health services include, diagnostic evaluation, individual & family counseling, case management and psychiatric services. SBHI delivers these services in Warren, Montgomery, Preble and Miami Counties.



SBHI's School Services offers mental health counseling in the school setting in Montgomery and Miami counties.

Consumer Advocacy Mode program offers mental health and substance treatment services to individuals 18 and older who are severely mentally ill and often dealing with substance abuse.
